## **Scholarships**

Great River Energy, a not-for-profit generation and transmission cooperative, sponsors a scholarship program for graduating seniors who are pursuing a four-year or vocational-technical degree. This year, up to six \$500-1,000 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors.

### **Eligibility**

- Any senior from Garrison, Max, Underwood, Turtle Lake-Mercer, Washburn, Wilton, Valley City, Barnes County North, and Jamestown
- Any senior planning to enroll in a full-time course of study at a North Dakota college, university, or vocational-technical school during the 2025-2026 school year. Funds are to be used for educational costs only
- Must be citizens of the United States
- You do not have to be related to a Great River Energy employee to receive this scholarship

#### **Deadline**

The application must be sent directly to Rae Ann Eilola by email (<a href="reilola@grenergy.com">reilola@grenergy.com</a>). Email is delivery is preferred.

Scholarships will be announced in early May 2025. Scholarship funds will be awarded **after** the completion of the first semester of postsecondary school if the student has maintained at least a 2.5 GPA.
